## ATHLONE GOLF CLUB – LOCAL RULES

### **OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 18.2)**

- 1(a) Over all boundary fences, white lines or posts defining out of bounds and white lines at gate on 3rd hole and car
- (b) Practice putting green adjacent to car park, clubhouse enclosure, machinery compound
- (c) When playing the 13th hole a ball coming to rest on or outside the area defined by black and white stakes.
- (d) A ball crossing any public road and coming to rest in another part of the course.
- (e) Lough Ree on the 16th hole

#### INTEGRAL PARTS OF THE COURSE

Stone support walls to teeing areas

The internal out of bounds stakes when playing on the 13th

### **IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (Rule 16.1)**

- 1 (a) The internal out of bounds posts when playing the 12th hole
- (b) All ropes, metal and plastic stakes protecting putting green surrounds
- (c) All artificially surfaced roads and paths
- (d) Toilet building at 11th/15th hole

# IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO THE **PUTTING GREEN**

In addition to the types of interference described in Rule 16.1a, when a ball lies in the general area, interference also exists if an immovable obstruction is: on the player's line of play, is within two club-lengths of the putting green, and is within two club-lengths of the ball. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b. (Exception - There is no relief under this Local Rule if the player chooses a line of play that is clearly unreasonable.)

#### **GROUND UNDER REPAIR**

Areas in bunkers where sand has been removed by the movement of water resulting in deep furrows through the sand are Ground Under Repair

Exposed tree roots and embedded rocks that are in a part of the general area cut to fairway height, except that there is no relief if they only interfere with the player's stance
